The Christmas Story

To some people's astonishment and everyone's delight, **The Christmas Story** will be in town again this year and will also be going into schools themselves for the first time – the donkeys as well as the puppets! Matthew Dixon of Cathays has asked whether we know anyone who can help so here are the things they need.

1. **Puppet People** – not full-scale puppeteering. The puppets are wired in place. Behind the puppets are two people, all in black, who tweak their hands and heads to bring the story to life. It is unbelievably effective, and very easily learned. (Each telling takes 5 minutes.)

2. **Father Christmas** The stints are quite short – visiting a school, and collecting the children's letters in your sack. It will be LOVELY. And our costume is just the best.

3. **Donkey whisperers** You'll be at the school between 10 and 2pm while the classes come out in batches to meet the donkeys. You'll have a gazebo for shelter. You needn't be in the pen with the donkeys – and you'll get a dinner-time breather.

4. **Lifts** During the 12 days of Christmas (weekdays – 1st- 16th December) could you offer lifts to any puppet people, donkey people and Santas who may need transport to get to a school?

5. **Town people** to help keep the show on the road at St John's church, the Hayes, where there will also be puppets and donkeys for EVERYBODY in Cardiff. We need a couple of stewards here, to check that the 3 people outside get cuppas and comfort breaks. Stints are 4 hours – and the church is open for a sit-down and a warm up.
