- ❖ **Cardiff Foodbank:** I am writing to say thank you for the donation of 27.8 kg of food in the period April-June 2022 from Cyncoed Methodist. This equates to 3 meals a day for 3 days for 2 people.
We really appreciate your support at this challenging time. You are helping us to make a difference in the lives of people in real need, and we couldn't do this without you. During April 2021 to March 2022 just under 156 tonnes of emergency food and provisions were distributed. 12,726 three day emergency food parcels were provided to local people in crisis by Cardiff Foodbank - of this 4871 (38%) went to children.
