make change number four.

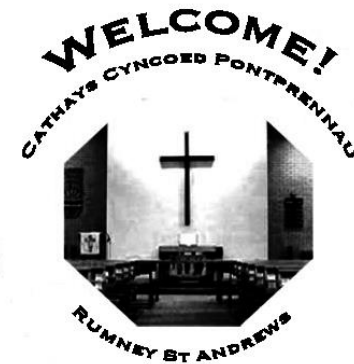
So you understand that God delights
