Love your relationships, not how you look *(Romans)*

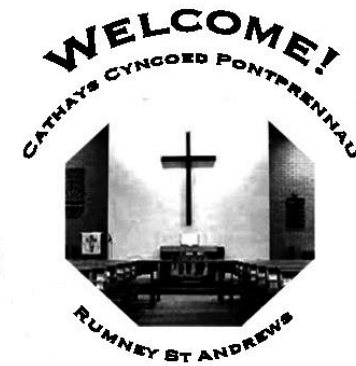
Wise decisions may not always make you rich but you'll feel like a million dollars *(Proverbs)*
