We arrived in Gethsemane and could hardly see a thing – a night almost too dark for shadows. Jesus told us he felt overwhelmed, sensed the closeness of death. He'd taken three of us into the deepest part of the garden. There to keep watch

His prayer that night has always stayed with me: Abba, Father, let this hour pass from me, let this cup be taken away from me. You can do that. Everything is possible with you. There was a pause then where he seemed to say nothing. Perhaps he was listening or perhaps he was just trying to find the words. Then I heard him eventually say: Not what I want, Father, but what you want.

And that was it. Whatever he may or may not have said after that, I missed because I couldn't keep my eyes open any longer. The very next thing I remember was him shaking my shoulder and saying: 'Simon, could you not keep watch for one hour? Stay awake with me. Pray that you will not drift into temptation. You want to do the right thing but your body is letting you down tonight.'

He'd called me *Simon*, my first name, not *Peter*, the rock. I was mortified. How could I have failed so utterly? Because I was exhausted. James and John had dropped off as well but I had been chosen to lead so, for me, it felt a whole lot worse. I was the night fisherman who never lost concentration. If I could do it in a boat, why on earth couldn't I do it in a garden?

But that's weakness for you – it takes you when you least expect it. Up to that moment, I thought I could be my master's right-hand man. Afterwards, I knew better. All I could hope for was to be his forgiven friend.

We continue to pray for those members of our Church Family and Friends who are unwell and all those who mourn.
