I went to say sorry and that seemed totally inadequate. What a complete idiot I'd been. But then what else would most other people have thought? Eventually I took the deepest of deep breaths and said: 'My Lord ... and my God.'

Jesus turned and looked straight at me: 'You believe because you have seen me,' he said. 'Just think what a blessing, what a joy it is and will be for those who have not seen this and yet still can believe.'
