### **A bit of background**

The second part of *Chronicles* starts and ends with Solomon's Temple building. In between, it deals with a people who show a very variable faith in God, and kings who offer some seriously flawed leadership. But there is a bright side. People's faith may wobble but God's faithfulness doesn't.

### **A snippet from the book**

After the Temple is built, God takes a quiet night-time moment to speak with his king. 'I've heard your prayers,' he tells him, 'and this is my promise. If people are sorry when they do wrong and turn back to me, I will forgive them. And, if you are faithful to me, I will be faithful to you. But, if you all go your own way, your magnificent building will mean nothing at all.'

- Buildings are good but God is so much better than any place erected to him.
- God's treasure is held not in walls and roofs but in his rules for living well and getting on together.
- Don't let your tongue run away from your brain.
- Seek to be true even if it's unpopular.
- If you want to help people, be sure to be well-organised
